DECISION AND ORDER

Appellant State Trial Attorneys Association (hereafter STAA) has requested the Public Employment Relations Board (hereafter Board) to reconsider its decision in State of California, California Department of Transportation (3/17/81) PERB Decision No. 159-S. In that Decision, the Board denied STAA's petition to stay the election in Unit 2.

The Board finds that extraordinary circumstances do not exist in the present case.¹ Accordingly, the request for reconsideration is DENIED.
