OPINION


This administrative appeal presents two requests for expedited treatment of the present case by the Board. If the requests were granted, the Board itself would consider the appeal of this case prior to some or all of the cases now prior to it on the Board's docket.

The request filed by the San Rafael Federation of Teachers, Local 1077 asserts that the issue presented by this case is of significance to approximately one dozen communities throughout the state. The request filed by San Rafael Teachers Association, CTA/NEA states that its petition has been pending since April 1, 1976 when the Association filed its request for recognition as exclusive representative of a unit of certificated employees.


These arguments supporting expedited treatment apply not only to this case, but also to every case prior to it on the Board's docket. Therefore, no compelling reason has been shown to persuade the Board to expedite its hearing of this case prior to those which have earlier filed exceptions, and the requests are denied.

ORDER

The requests for expedited treatment of this case, filed by San Rafael Federation of Teachers, Local 1077 and by San Rafael Teachers Association, CTA/NEA are denied by the Board itself.
