ORDER

The Reef-Sunset Unified School District appeals a determination by the Sacramento Regional Director dismissing a request for recognition filed by the West Kings County Teachers Association, CTA/NEA. The regional director determined that the authorization cards submitted in support of the Association's request were signed by employees of two separate school districts because the Reef-Sunset Unified School District will not in fact become an actual school district until July 1, 1980. The new district is being formed by combining a portion of the Lemoore Union High School District with the entirety of the Reef-Sunset Union Elementary School District.

Public Employment Relations Board does not approve or dismiss requests for recognition. Its role is to check the showing of support against an employee list for compliance with section 3544(b) of the Educational Employment Relations Act (EERA), and notify the employer of its findings. However, as the facts in this case reveal, no employee list was submitted and therefore, the regional office could not perform this function. The regional director should request such a list from the Reef-Sunset Unified School District, then take such action as may be appropriate.

The appeal is granted, the matter remanded for request for employee list.
