DECISION AND ORDER

HESSE, Chairperson: The Kelseyville Unified School District (District) appeals the administrative determination of the San Francisco Regional Director, granting the California School Employees Association and its Chapter 638 (Association) its request to stay a decertification election, pursuant to the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) Regulation 32752, pending the resolution of three unfair practice charges filed by the Association against the District. Subsequent to the filing

of this appeal, the original petitioner, Group of Employees (by Donna Murphey) withdrew the petition for decertification.¹

A case in controversy becomes moot when the essential nature of the complaint is lost because of some superseding act or acts of the parties. (Fontana Unified School District (1988) PERB Order Ad-169, p. 3, citing Napa County Office of Education (1983) PERB Decision No. 282 and Amador Valley Joint Union High School District (1978) PERB Decision No. 74.) Since the underlying petition has been withdrawn, continuing the stay of a decertification election would not be appropriate.

Due to the withdrawal of the underlying decertification petition, the Board ORDERS that the stay of the decertification election is hereby LIFTED and the appeal of the administrative determination in Case No. SF-D-173 is hereby DISMISSED AS MOOT.
