DECISION

WHITEHEAD, Member: This case is before the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) on a request by George Sarka (Sarka) to receive special permission to appeal the refusal of a Board agent to disqualify herself from investigation of his unfair practice charge under PERB Regulation 32155(d)¹.

After review of the record, including Sarka's request to the Board agent that she disqualify herself, the Board agent's denial of the request, and Sarka's request for special permission from the Board to appeal the Board agent's refusal to disqualify herself, the Board denies Sarka's request.

ORDER

George Sarka's request for special permission to appeal the Board agent's refusal to disqualify herself from investigation of Case No. LA-CE-811-H is hereby DENIED.
